SECOND EXTENSION OF FOURTH AMENDED
DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY AND ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

ORDER

Pursuant to the authority granted to me by Louisiana Revised Statutes (La. R.S.) 30:2001, *et seq.*, and particularly La. R.S. 30:2011(D)(6) and 2033, I hereby find that the emergency conditions set forth in the *Fourth Amended Declaration of Emergency and Administrative Order* regarding Hurricane Ida and its aftermath continue to exist in the parishes of Ascension, Assumption, East Baton Rouge, East Feliciana, Iberia, Iberville, Jefferson, LaFourche, Livingston, Orleans, Plaquemines, Pointe Coupee, St. Bernard, St. Charles, St. Helena, St. James, St. John the Baptist, St. Martin, St. Mary, St. Tammany, Tangipahoa, Terrebonne, Washington, West Baton Rouge, and West Feliciana. Therefore, I do hereby extend the *Fourth Amended Declaration of Emergency and Administrative Order*, which shall take effect immediately upon my signature and shall expire at **11:59P.M. on the 29th day of January, 2022.**
